

# Visitor's Guide

Bring your sense of adventure on an exploration through the rainforest!



- Wear comfy shoes the wildlife park is best explored on foot. You'll be walking, climbing and discovering!
- Be prepared for all-weather conditions dress light, bring a hat, and wear sunscreen. Pack an umbrella or raincoat, in case it rains.
- Stay hydrated be sure to bring a water bottle to refresh yourself.
- Stay safe keep to marked trails and walkways, and follow all park activity guidelines. Approach our friendly rangers for tips on enjoying the park!
- Eat and drink in designated areas do not bring food and beverages into the walk-in habitats.
- Keep your trash with you there are no bins in the walk-in habitats and along the trails. Please dispose

your trash in the designated wildlife-proof bins.

• Take your time to wander and explore – listen to nature's cues, the rustling of leaves, or the soft padding of animals moving through the underbrush.

## Ensuring a safe visit for everyone

For the welfare of our animals and for your safety, please follow the guidelines and signages throughout the park.

#### **Respect the animals**

Please be respectful of our animals. Do not shout, corner, run after our animals, or throw objects in their habitats. These are their homes! Enjoy observing them from a safe distance, allowing them to move freely in their environment. If you need help, wave to the staff on ground.

#### **Stay within boundaries**

The open-concept habitats have been designed to allow for the best possible experience with our animals. Please keep to designated walkways and avoid crossing fences or barriers. Our rangers are available to assist you on your rainforest adventure.

#### Do not feed the animals

Our animals have customised diets to ensure their well-being and health, and have sufficient access to food that they need.

#### No flash photography

Our animals are sensitive to bright lights. Please refrain from using flash photography on our animals.

#### No smoking

To decrease fire hazards and ensure the safety and health of the animals, smoking is not permitted on property. Please head to the designated smoking points.

#### Children must be supervised

We love that kids are spending time outdoors and are curious about their surroundings. But we also want them to stay safe. Keep an eye on them and ensure they are supervised at all times.
